Southern Los Angeles County Youth Championship Rules

1. **ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all bowlers currently holding youth membership with a USBC Association.
2. **TOURNAMENT DATES:** January 19-20, 2019 (Team Event) and January 26-27, 2019 (Singles & Doubles).
3. **COMPETITION:** The Southern LA County USBC Youth Championships will be a handicapped event consisting of 3 games per event. There will be 3 events, Team, Singles and Doubles. Multiple entries are allowed in each event; however a bowler may only place once in the top 5 for Singles.
4. Bowlers must check-in at least one hour prior to their scheduled squad time. Please bring USBC membership cards to check-in. All doubles and team members must check in together. Squads may start earlier, if everyone has checked in. All substitutions/replacements and walk-ins must be made thirty (30) minutes prior to scheduled squad time and must show current USBC membership at check-in. Verification of average must be submitted within 10 days of competition, otherwise bowler enters at 200. Once a replacement has started an event, they must complete that event except in the case of an emergency.
5. **ENTRY FEES:** Lineage \$9 + Expenses \$2 + Trophy \$2 + Scholarships \$7 = \$20 per event (\$80 team/\$80 DS). Optional All-events is \$5 per person. Make checks or money orders payable to: SLAC USBC (any returned checks are subject to a \$50 penalty fee). Walk-ins are accepted up to 30 minutes prior to the start of the squad time and only if space is available.
6. Entries will be processed and scheduled in the order they are received by the Tournament Director.
7. **TEAM EVENT:** Each team shall consist of 4 youth members of any combination. Multiple team entries are allowed provided at least one (1) team member is changed. Scores from the first team series bowled will be used for the All Events total.
8. **LINEUP:** Order cannot be changed from original entry form. Subs bowl in the position of original bowler.
9. **SINGLES/DOUBLES:** Doubles teams shall consist of 2 members of any combination. Bowlers entering the doubles event must also enter Singles. Multiple Singles/Doubles entries are allowed provided one (1) team member is changed. Scores from the first series bowled will be used for the All Events total.
10. **OPTIONAL ALL-EVENTS:** All-Events scores is a 9 game total comprised of the first 3 game series bowled in Team, Singles and Doubles. Entrants may only enter All-Events once.
11. **PHIL SHELTON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP TOURNAMENT:** The top 10 All-Events scores (male and female) will be eligible to compete in the Phil Shelton Memorial Scholarship tournament. Ages for this event is based on the bowler's age as of August 1, 2018.
12. **ENTERING AVERAGE:** Average to be used for this tournament will be a minimum of 12 games in order of the following:
 - a. Highest USBC certified average as of January 1, 2019 (provide league sheet); if none,
 - b. Highest USBC certified average for 2017-18 season; If none,
 - c. Highest USBC current certified average at time of competition (provide league sheet), if none,
 - d. Enter at 200 (Scratch)

Any average obtained through a "Sport" or "Challenge" league will be adjusted. This adjustment, by USBC standard, is not considered a "re-rate" of the bowler, and is not treated as such. Its purpose is to allow for a fair adjustment to what would be expected of the bowler on a standard league condition.

13. **DIVISIONS:** There are 3 average based divisions in each event.
14. **HANDICAPS:** Handicaps will be computed on the 3 game series based on 100% of the difference between the entering average and 200 (Singles/All-Events, 400 (Doubles) or 800 (Team).
15. **TROPHIES & SCHOLARSHIPS:** A trophy will be awarded to the 1st place finisher in each event and division. Additional scholarships awarded based on a ratio of at least 1:10. Awards and Scholarship fees returned 100%. Scholarships held with USBC SMART, (800) 514-2695 x8292.
16. **BOWLING ATTIRE:** All bowlers must wear attire suitable for a YOUTH tournament. No alcoholic, tobacco, sexual or profane advertisements or references are allowed on any attire or equipment. Bowlers are also not allowed to wear tank tops, halter tops, sweats, spandex, cut offs or hats of any kind. Walking shorts, skorts and skirts are allowed provided that the hemline extends past the fingertips when arms are at the sides.
17. No smoking during tournament play. Non-alcoholic drinks and food are permissible in the back area only.
18. Action on the lanes, which is considered unsportsmanlike or disruptive, will not be tolerated. Conduct derogatory to the best interest of youth bowling in conjunction with USBC will result in immediate disqualification (Refer to rule 17D) and forfeiture of any fees and awards.
19. In Team event, only one (1) bowling ball for each entrant allowed on the rack. In Doubles and Singles event, no more than two (2) bowling balls for each entrant allowed on the rack.
20. TARDY bowlers shall start in the frame currently being bowled. A zero (0) shall be scored for all missed frames. There shall be no BLIND scores or pacers.
21. Any person who bowls under an assumed name, under the name of another person scheduled to bowl in the tournament, or who is under suspension from USBC membership shall be disqualified and will forfeit any fees and awards. They will also be subject to suspension from USBC membership.
22. Observe one (1) lane courtesy only.
23. Altering the surface of a bowling ball by the use of abrasives while bowling in USBC competition is prohibited. All bowling balls so altered must be removed from the competition. (See the USBC Equipment Specifications Manual on BOWL.com.) The use of approved cleaning agents listed in the Approved Anytime section of the Approved Cleaners and Polishes list is permissible. If it is determined the bowler had prior knowledge that the actions were in violation of USBC Rule 18, the game(s) in which the violation occurred is subject to forfeiture and the bowler is subject to disqualification, loss of entry fee, and possible USBC suspension.
24. Any disputes must be filed in writing with the tournament director prior to the awarding of scholarships. (USBC rule #329). Interpretation and enforcement of tournament rules shall be at the discretion of the SLAC USBC tournament director and designated directors.
25. **All adult volunteers (18 and over) must have and wear a Registered Volunteer badge (RVP) in order to be in the bowler's area while youth bowlers are present.**
26. ANY AND ALL APPLICABLE RULES NOT COVERED ABOVE SHALL BE GOVERNED BY UNITED STATES BOWLING CONGRESS RULES, REGULATIONS AND GUIDELINES.
