Southern LA County USBC Association (SLAC USBC)
NO-TAP SINGLES TOURNAMENT RULES

1. This tournament is open to all current SLAC USBC members in good standing. SLAC USBC membership is \$25 for a standard adult card, \$14 for standard youth card and \$10 for transfer. A \$5 fee will be charged per card for any on-site membership processing.
2. **FORMAT:** This tournament will consist of four (4) games no-tap singles moving pairs after game #2. Total pins plus handicap, when applicable, will determine the champions in each division.
3. This tournament shall take place on February 8, 2020 at **DEL RIO LANES**, 7502 Florence Ave, Downey, CA 90240, (562) 927-3351. **Closing date:** February 8, 2020 at 12:15pm. **DO NOT MAIL AFTER FEBRUARY 4.**
4. **AVERAGES:** USBC rule 319a-2 is waived. The individual entering average shall use the highest of the following:
 - a. Highest USBC certified league average of 21 games or more for the 2017-18 or 2018-19 season (winter/summer). If none;
 - b. Highest current USBC certified average (min. of 21 games) as of tournament date (sheet required). If none,
 - c. Scratch 210

Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own averages. If a "sport" or "modified" league average is the bowler's only verifiable average, it will be adjusted per the USBC sport chart to determine the correct entering average. USBC rules 319a2 (10 pin increase in average), 319d (reporting of prize winnings) and 319e (15 pin increase in accumulated tournament average) will be waived.
5. A bowler whose average has been re-adjusted by any tournament committee must report the readjusted average when submitting an entry. The re-adjusted average (or highest average) will be used for twenty-four (24) months from the date of notification.
6. **ENTRY FEE:** Prize/Scholarship: \$22 + Lineage: \$13 + Expenses: \$5 = **\$40 per person**. Checks or money orders will be accepted made payable to **SOUTHERN LA COUNTY USBC**. Write "No-Tap Singles" in memo. Any returned checks must be paid in cash or money order on-site plus a \$40 penalty fee.
7. **Bowlers must check in one hour prior to scheduled squad time and must show proof of membership by showing their USBC membership card or a [bowl.com](http://www.bowl.com) printout.**
8. Replacements and walk-ins must be processed at least 45 minutes prior to the squad time. **BOWL.COM PRINTOUTS MUST BE PROVIDED.**
9. **HANDICAP: 90% of 210**
10. Late bowlers shall start in the frame currently being bowled. Missed frames shall be credited with a zero. Bowlers not present to bowl when it's their turn will be credited with a zero for that frame. In the event a bowler cannot finish their series, zero points will be scored the remaining frames.
11. **DRESS CODE:** Dress appropriately for a championship tournament. No sexual or profane advertisements will be allowed on any attire or equipment. NO tank tops, halter tops, sweats, spandex, "cut-off's" or short shorts of any kind allowed. Walking shorts, "skorts" and skirts are permitted. Tournament management shall determine the validity of any complaints.
12. **Only a dry towel may be used to clean bowling balls during USBC competition.**
13. All prize money/scholarships will be returned 100%. The prize ratio is based on a ratio of at least 1:8. In the event of ties, co-champions will be declared and prize money will be combined and divided equally. Scholarships will be held with USBC SMART Acct #11334, (800) 514-2695 x8292.
14. Designated prize funds will be paid accordingly to each division within 30 days upon completion of the tournament, except when USBC nationals has authorized delay in payment, pending settlement of any claim or protest which effects position standings.
15. Claims for errors in scoring or general playing rules must be made to the tournament director no later than the start of the next block or 30 minutes after the completion of competition. Questionable errors shall be decided upon by the tournament director. All other protests must be confirmed in writing to the tournament director within 72 hours or before the awards are presented. Under this rule, each protest must be specific in itself.
16. This tournament will be certified by USBC. The tournament director shall be the authority to interpret USBC and tournament rules, policies and procedures in deciding disputes. If deemed necessary, the tournament director shall consult with the board of directors of the SLAC USBC.
17. An appeal or protest of a decision involving eligibility or playing rules must be filed in writing with the tournament director and the USBC before tournament prizes are paid. The decision of USBC is final and binding on all involved parties. Any violation of tournament rules is cause for disqualification, loss of entry fee, forfeit of all prize monies and possible suspension from USBC membership.
18. **Fees are refundable ONLY when the Tournament Director is notified, in writing, within 15 days of the schedule notice mailing, that the date and time assigned are not acceptable, or in the case of an emergency, at the discretion of Tournament Director.**
